Bi-lingual counselors and interpreters (Spanish) are available upon request.

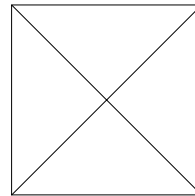
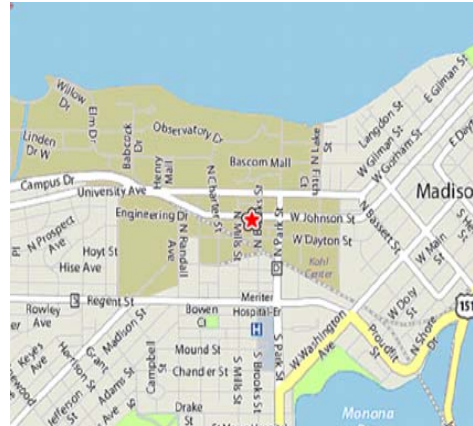


## Transportation to the Clinic

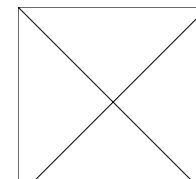
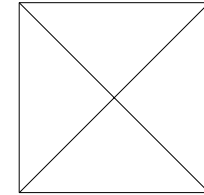
## Map to Clinic

## Services

The Counseling Psychology Clinic provides services to children, adolescents and adults. Services provided include:

Services are provided by Counseling Psychology graduate students and post-master's counselors supervised by licensed psychologists and counselors.

## Services not Provided

We do not provide crisis intervention, medication, and services for ongoing sexual or physical abuse

## Fees

Fees for counseling services are on a sliding scale based on family income. Fees for assessment services are based on the nature of the evaluation and the time required to complete the evaluation.
